2016: YEAR IN REVIEW

What a year! An outstanding national conference

in Kelowna, expanded collaboration with the 4Rs Indigenous youth movement, investment in STEM education with the launch of our STEAM Ahead program, added funding for scholarships—the list goes on. And yet the diversity of our work only clarifies our goal: if a young person needs it, our Clubs provide it.

Now more than ever, we want to share that message with the world. Even though we are Canada's largest child- and youth-serving agency, we are not always in the public eye. Tucked away behind schools, in community centres, or in neighbourhoods off the beaten path, Boys and Girls Clubs quietly work where we are needed. It is time to raise our profile and reach even more young people and their families.

Becoming a household name means being recognized as a strong voice for children and youth in Canada. When we saw the federal government's priorities align with ours this year, we amped up our advocacy and policy efforts, and we saw results. Our YOUTH in Office event, where young leaders job shadow an MP on Parliament Hill for a day, resulted in a Twitter chat that trended #2 in Canada. We also doubled our engagement on Facebook—we currently have over 20,000 followers.

In our first year as Chair and CEO, we have had a front row seat to the range of services our Clubs offer. We are before and after school, weekends and evenings. We are daycares and preschool. We are breakfast programs, after school snacks, dinner, nutrition programs. We are tutoring and scholarships. We are music and arts studios. We are leadership development, recreation, sports leagues. We welcome newcomers, and send kids to camp. We are all this and more.

We intend to build on the success of 2016 as we move forward with a strong national team and the continued dedication of our Club staff, volunteers, and supporters. Thanks to all of you, we have set the foundation for what is certain to be an incredible 2017.

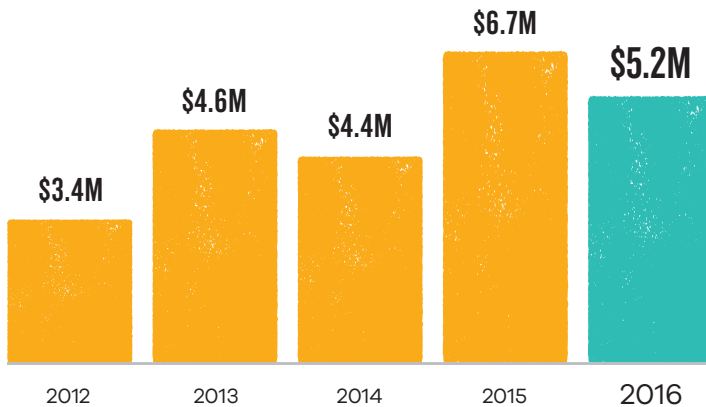
